Lady's high polished 14 karat yellow gold cocktail ring featuring an oval faceted mixed cut blue natural sapphire elevated in four prongs surrounded by fourteen round single cut diamonds in one-prong settings braced against the frame under the sapphire. The ring also holds six round single cut diamonds in two closed channels across each side of the tapering squared edge band. The diamonds in the crown are 2.0 to 2.1 mm in diameter each and the twelve diamonds in the band range from 1.7 to 2.0 mm in diameter each. The twenty-six diamonds weigh an estimated 3/4 carat together and are (I₁-I₂) clarity and (H-I) color with good cut grade. The sapphire measures 8.3 mm long by 6.7 mm wide by 4.01 mm deep and weighs an estimated 2 carats; it is medium dark slightly grayish blue color and transparent (I₁) clarity on the Type II gemstone scale with good polish, good symmetry and good light return. The ring is of cast manufacture and is stamped inside the band with 14K; it is in excellent condition and weighs 8.7 grams complete.

ESTIMATED REPLACEMENT COST: \$1,600.00

The subjectivity of appraising allows some variations in grading and valuation with alternate appraisals. This appraisal has been prepared in conformity with generally accepted professional standards following the Code of Professional Ethics of the National Association of Jewelry Appraisers and the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP); it is incomplete without the cover page and the limiting conditions statement.
