Lady's high polished 18 karat yellow gold cocktail ring with a spray design square crown turned 45 degrees supported by the split shoulders of the 2 mm wide rounded band. It holds thirteen round brilliant cut diamonds in four-prong rope framed settings in three tiers. Twelve of the diamonds range from 2.6 to 2.9 mm in diameter each and the center diamond (estimated 0.35 carat) measures 4.5 mm in diameter. The diamonds weigh an estimated 1-1/3 carats combined and are (VS₂-SI₂) clarity and (G-H) color with good to very good cut grade. The ring is of cast fabrication and is stamped inside the band with 18K; it weighs 5.8 grams and is in excellent condition.

ESTIMATED REPLACEMENT COST: \$4,000.00

The subjectivity of appraising allows some variations in grading and valuation with alternate appraisals. This appraisal has been prepared in conformity with generally accepted professional standards following the Code of Professional Ethics of the National Association of Jewelry Appraisers and the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP); it is incomplete without the cover page and the limiting conditions statement.
